


On the road



1. How many lanes can you see on this busy freeway? 2. Buffalos are dangerous. Do not approach them.




3. Signs welcome you to every state and city. 4. Sometimes signs sound like your grandma.

DID YOU KNOW?

Every school day almost 24 million children in the US take the yellow school bus to go to school. But why are the school buses yellow? Yellow is a very bright color. Scientists say that we see yellow 1.24 times faster than other colors. The color yellow is easy to see even in bad weather.



In the US the speed limit on highways is usually from 65 to 70 miles per hour. Texas has the highest highway speed limit in the US. On a road between Austin and San Antonio you can drive 85 miles per hour!
